Covid 19 – Information for University and College Admissions Teams

Covid-19 has had an impact on students at Shrewsbury High School.

When schools closed in March 2020 under the national COVID-19 lockdown procedures, our teaching was moved online and we transitioned to Guided Home Learning using Microsoft Teams. Students continued to attend lessons when possible and teachers took the opportunity to be creative and encourage a greater degree of independence from students.

This year's Year 13 Students were awarded GCSE grades using the Teacher Assessed Grading system in the Summer of 2021 and started their A Level programmes of study in the Autumn of 2021. Their classroom teaching was disrupted again during the second national lockdown in the Spring of 2021 and our students continued to demonstrate resilience, determination and self motivation during our Guided Home Learning programme.

Students sat rigorous Summer Assessments in June 2022. UCAS Predicted grades are being based on these results, previous attainment at GCSE, ALIS predictions, other assessments and work completed in year 12, value added from mock-GCSE exams to final assessments and staff professional judgement based on knowing our Year 13 cohort very well.
