

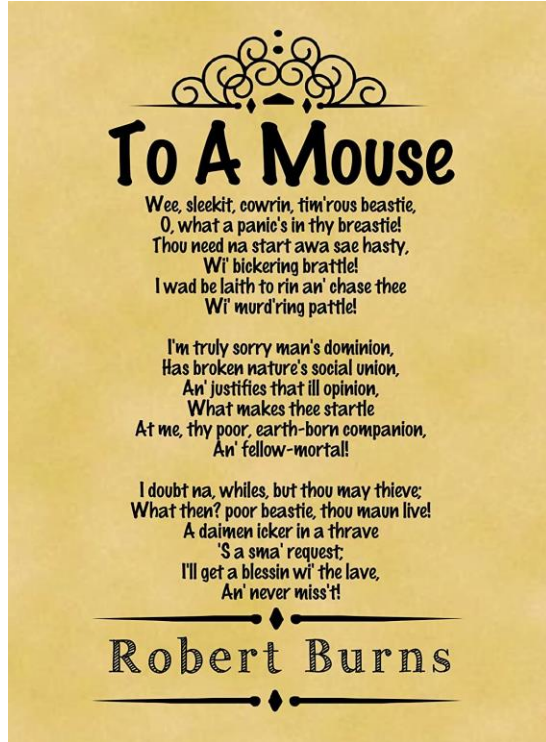


What is BURNS night?
